

CANBERRA CROQUET CLUB REGULATIONS - COMMERCIAL ADVERTISING

The Club's policy is to encourage the widespread dissemination of information about the sport of croquet to its members and the public at large. This includes both commercial advertising as well as basic material.

Because of the limited size of the Clubhouse it is not practicable or appropriate to give an unlimited right of access to manufacturers/agents to advertise and display their products. The Club will however, make every effort to make space available.

Pending the availability of additional space, one noticeboard is to be made available for commercial advertising; to ensure equitable treatment between users, individual items must be no large than A4 size.

This general policy does not prevent the Club from incorporating a "trade display" such as part of a tournament or where there is sponsorship of an event.

Non-Commercial Items

The display and promotion of non-commercial items, i.e. Club, CNSW and ACA products, while not covered by this policy, should be guided by its intent.

General

The General Committee is responsible for all decisions on commercial advertising; material is not to be displayed until authorised by the Committee.

The Executive is authorised to negotiate with potential advertisers within the parameters above.
