## CROQUET RESOURCES

### *Library Items*

The club has a good library of croquet books and tapes. The library cupboard is located on the left corner of the main clubhouse room. Members are welcome to borrow from the library. Please sign out items in the lending book provided.

The World Gateball Union Rule Book is also available in the club library.

There are also a number of croquet books available through the public library system in Canberra. Most of these are quite old but provide good reference material for the newer player.

Care needs to be taken with any books or information published before 2000 as they will not reflect the current laws of Association or Golf Croquet.

### *Web Sites*
